## **Safety**

- 1. in order to participate in the lab, you will have to sign the safety form. Your TA will provide this for you along with any safety training required for the lab.
- 2. Safety training for General Physics Labs consists of the following:
  - (a) No open toed shoes allowed in the lab
  - (b) No shorts or skirts allowed in the lab
  - (c) Safety glasses must be worn during certain experiments as identified by Bill Luebke
