



As you bask in your glorious landing at the end of *Talon's Galactic Trip*, take a minute to complete a final check of all the steps along your journey. **Here is the rundown of everything you need to do by August 19 (Fall 24 classes begin on this date):**

- Check out the Access Illinois Tech portal and your Hawk email
- Sign up for IIT Alert
- Submit your Room and Board Contract or Housing Waiver Application
- Submit final transcripts and AP/IB/A-Level exam scores for course credit
- Complete online pre-arrival module
- Register for SOAR: New Student Orientation and upload your HawkCard ID photo
- Complete the necessary academic assessments, schedule your initial advising appointment with your adviser, and register for courses
- Financial aid requirements**
 - Begin completing your financial aid checklist, if necessary
- Attend SOAR: New Student Orientation
- Submit health and immunization documents
- Waive Illinois Tech health insurance, if applicable
- Pick up HawkCard ID and U-Pass when you arrive on campus
